It is therefore this 28th day of June A. D. 1856 by this Court adjudged ordered and decreed that the real estate mentioned in the proceedings in this Cause be sold - that John A. Simmons of Frederick's County be and he is hereby appointed trustee to make such sale and that the course and manner of his proceedings shall be as follows.
