 day of April 1857 a bill was filed in your Honorable
 Court by your petitioners William McRefect and others against
 Nathaniel Suf & wife for the sale of the real estate of Elizabeth
 McRefect, dec'd for distribution among her heirs at law -
 that on the 3^d day of September 1857 a decree was passed by your
 Honor for the sale of said real estate and appointing John
 B. Picking one of your petitioners trustee to execute said sale
 that as such trustee he sold said property for the sum of
 five hundred and twenty eight dollars & twenty cents &
 duly reported said sale to your Honor and that said has
 been duly ratified by your Honor all of which will fully appear

 be taken as a part of this petition if here inserted.

 sum of ten dollars & ninety seven cents for services rendered
 as appears by his account filed herewith as claim N^o 3 that
 your petitioner John B. Picking as trustee aforesaid paid
 said account due said Breighner as appears by his receipt
 indorsed on said account and has also paid to Ross & Bushman
 nine dollars for a Coffin for said Elizabeth McRefect as appears
 by their account & receipt filed herewith as claim N^o 4 that said
 Elizabeth McRefect died leaving no personal estate for the payment
 of said debt & funeral expenses & your petitioners therefore pray that
 they may be allowed their said claims out of the proceeds
 of the sale of the real estate of said deceased now in the hands of
 said trustee and that your Honor will pass an order directing
 the auditor in settling the account in this case to allow said
 claims subject to the future order of the Court & your petitioners will
 in pray &c
