Otto a daughter of said intestate and who married Lewis Smith of Frederick's County 5th Peter Otto a son of said intestate and who resides in Carroll County 6th Mary E. a daughter of said intestate and who married Paul Anderson and died before said intestate leaving the following children: Margaret Anders who married John M.
