Further it is my will that any Negroes that may be born of any of the female slave women during my lifetime be sold at private Sale and the proceeds divided equally between my children share and share alike.


And Lastly I do hereby appoint my son Life T. Boyer and Dora Williana Executors of the only last will and testament making all former Wills by me at any time heretofore made ratifying and confirming this and none other to be my last Will and testament.
