The Bill states that J. B. Washington Harlan was a single sister of administration on the estate of Nancy Harlan she having died intestate and that the personal property of the said intestate is nothing like sufficient to pay her just debt. The Bill states that the said Nancy Harlan died without leaving any children and that James W. Harlan Joseph Harlan Mary Harlan J. B. Washington Harlan Ellen Anders the wife of said Moses Anders and Catharine Harlan are her sisters and sisters and only heirs at Law, that the said Joseph Harlan Mary Harlan and Catharine Harlan reside out of the state of Maryland.

It is therefore the 2^d day of January 1860 adjudged and prayed that the Complainant Cause be Copy of this order to be inserted in some newspaper printed in Frederick City once in each of four successive weeks before the 5th day of February next giving to the said Joseph Harlan Mary Harlan + Catharine Harlan the absent defendants notice of the object of this Bill warning them to be and appear in this Court on or before the first Monday of May next to answer said bill of Complaint and to show cause if any they have why a decree should not pass as prayed.
