D. 1859. Whereas by a decree of the Circuit Court for Frederick's County in a Court of Equity bearing date the 20th day of August A. D. 1859 and passed in a Cause in the said Court wherein Henry A. Paddica & wife are Complainants & Sarah M. Mercer and others are Defendants the above bound Henry A. Paddica has been appointed trustee to make sale of certain real estate in the proceedings in said Cause mentioned.

Now the Condition of the above obligation is such that if the above bound Henry A. Paddica do and shall well & faithfully perform the trust reposed in him by any future order or decree in the premises then the above obligation to be void otherwise to remain in full force & virtue in law.
