At the request of George & Lewis Markell the following Mortgage was recorded February 6th 1861: This Mortgage made this sixth day of February in the year 1861 by Stephen Gantt Esq negro and Lemetta Gantt his wife of Frederick County in the State of Maryland. Whereas the said Stephen Gantt stands indebted unto the Franklin Savings Bank of Frederick in the sum of Three hundred and twenty five dollars upon a promissory note bearing date the 5th day of February in the year 1861 and payable 90 days after date upon which said promissory note G. Markell and Lewis Markell are the sureties of the said Stephen Gantt and the said Lemetta Gantt and the said Lemetta Gantt by wife being willing to secure and indemnify the said George Markell and Lewis Markell against all loss that might
