

a long time past and that he is and has been for a long time past engaged in cutting down and destroying and carrying away the timber and trees growing on said land and premises and that he is committing great waste on said land and is doing irreparable damage to the inheritance and that he has a large quantity of timber now cut and lying on said land and that if not restrained by your Honor he will utterly destroy the value of said land before a decree can be obtained for the sale thereof and therefore that the said William C. Grimes is utterly bankrupt and has no means whatev'er from your Honor and whatev'er can obtain indemnification for the injury he is now doing to said land and premises in your Honor's consideration whereof and for as much as your Honor and whatev'er are immediately in the premises said by the aid of your Honor and the said therefore that the said land and premises may be sold under the decree of your Honor and that the proceeds of the sale thereof may be distributed amongst the said parties entitled thereto, and that the said William C. Grimes and the said Samuel Stitely may disclose who is in fact entitled to the interest which the said William C. Grimes had in said lands as any heir at law of the said William Grimes, and that the said William C. Grimes may be restrained from cutting down and destroying and carrying away the timber and trees growing on said land and from carrying away the timber now cut and lying on said land and from injuring the said land and premises and that your Honor and whatev'er may have such other and further relief as in your Honor's equity as they may be entitled to may it please your Honor to grant to your Honor and whatev'er whatev'er of subpoena to be directed to the said Infant Joseph C. Grimes and also to the said William C. Grimes and Samuel Stitely all of the duties capacity commanding them and each of them on a certain day therein to be named to be and appear in your Honor's Court there and there to answer the premises and to stand to abide by & fulfil such order and decree as your Honor may make in the premises and further may it please your Honor to grant to your Honor and whatev'er a writ of injunction to be directed to the said William C. Grimes commanding and enjoining him by agents and servants to refrain from executing and give over the cutting down and destroying and carrying away the timber and trees growing on said land and from carrying away that now cut down and lying on said land and from injuring said land and diminishing the value thereof. And your Honor and whatev'er will give the
