Maryland Act

§ 3 The State of Maryland To the Sheriff of Frederick County Circuit Court. Whereas heretofore to wit, on the 8th day of January A. D. 1855 upon the Complaint of George Blefing and others William C. Grimes per agents and assigns and each of them were by an order of the Circuit Court for Frederick County sitting in Equity, strictly enjoined and prohibited from Cutting down, Destroying and Carrying away the timber upon the premises on which said William C. Grimes now resides being situate and lying in Frederick County - aforesaid, until the further order of this said Court.

And Whereas by the suggestion of the said Geo. Blefing supported by affidavit it appears to this Court here that the said William C. Grimes hath refused to obey the order aforesaid by this Court in manifest Contempt thereof. Therefore you are hereby Commanada to attach the said William C. Grimes if he shall be found in your bailiwick and have his body before the said Court forthwith as well to answer unto the State of Maryland for his Contempt in disobeying the order aforesaid as to such other matters and things as shall be then and there alleged against him.
