The complainants in the above cause in answer to the order laid on the 31st day of January last to show Cause why the Decree passed in the above Cause should not be vacated, and set aside show for cause as follows to wit:
1st That the matter alleged in the said petition of William C. Grimes on which said order to show Cause is founded do not show any sufficient Cause why the said Decree should be vacated as prayed and that for want of such sufficient Cause the said order ought to be granted & the said petition dismissed. 2^d Because the said petition of said William C. Grimes does not allege and show any Cause of disqualification of the Honorable the Judge of the Court to pass said Decree and because the said Judge was not of Counsel in the said Cause in which said Decree was passed and that the said Judge above had jurisdiction under the Constitution of this State to pass said Decree. 3^d Because the Term at which said Decree was passed had elapsed & passed before the filing of the said petition and it is not competent for the Court to vacate & set aside said Decree.
