Copy Mortgage

At the request of Edward Shiner & Nicholas Whitmore the following Mortgage was recorded August 7th 1860. This Mortgage made this 7th day of August in the year 1860 by Nicholas Whitmore and Elizabeth W. Whitmore his wife of Frederick County in the State of Maryland, Witnesses whereas the said Nicholas W. Whitmore together with Edward Shiner and Nicholas Whitmore of the County and State aforesaid and certain stamps indebted unto the Frederick Loan Savings Institution in the sum of \$2000 upon a promissory note bearing date the 2^d day of August instant, and payable six months after date and the said Nicholas W. Whitmore & Elizabeth W. Whitmore his wife being willing to secure and indemnify the said Edward Shiner and Nicholas Whitmore against all loss that might result from their said suretyship and said note or any proceeds thereof have agreed to execute these presents Nov. Therefore in consideration of the premises and of one dollar the said Nicholas W. Whitmore and Elizabeth W. Whitmore his wife do grant unto the said Edward Shiner & Nicholas Whitmore all those parts of tracts or parcels of land situated & lying in Frederick County aforesaid being part of a tract called Altogether and part of a tract called "Sharon Rest Centre" more together of Acres & Rods & 29 ps of land conveyed by the said Nicholas Whitmore to said Nicholas W. Whitmore of said
