


The said Nicholas Whitmore hereby expressly agreeing for himself his heirs and assigns out of this Conveyance the Spring or fountain situate on the premises herein conveyed and from which the farm now occupied by the said Nicholas Whitmore & which was devised to him by the late Nicholas Holt is supplied with water from ten feet of the land on all sides of said Spring and the right at any and at all times hereafter to enter into and upon such portion and so much of said premises as may be necessary with a sufficient number of workmen and hands as may be necessary for the purpose of cleaning and repairing said Spring or laying down new pipes or repairing the pipes which now convey the water from said Spring of Fountain to the farm and premises now owned and occupied by the said Nicholas Whitmore.
