thereupon the fifth day of March 1857 by Madison Nelson Circuit
Judge of the Third Judicial Circuit of the State of Maryland
and by the authority of the Circuit Court for Frederick's County -
as a Court of Equity, ordered, adjudged and decreed that Joshua
Biggs and William C. Landers of Frederick's County State of
Maryland be and they are hereby appointed Trustees to execute
the trusts contained in the will of William Duddeman deceased
in the place of David W. Duddeman the executor thereof who died
without executing the same and it is further ordered that the
said Trustees before proceeding to act shall first file with the
Clerk of this Court a bond to the State of Maryland in the
penalty of twenty thousand dollars with two or more sureties
to be approved by this Court or the Clerk thereof Conditioned -
for the faithful discharge of the trusts reposed in them by this
decree or which may be reposed in them by any future decree
or order in the premises, and it is further ordered that the
said Trustees once in every year shall file and true report -
under oath as to their execution of their trust make to the Court
