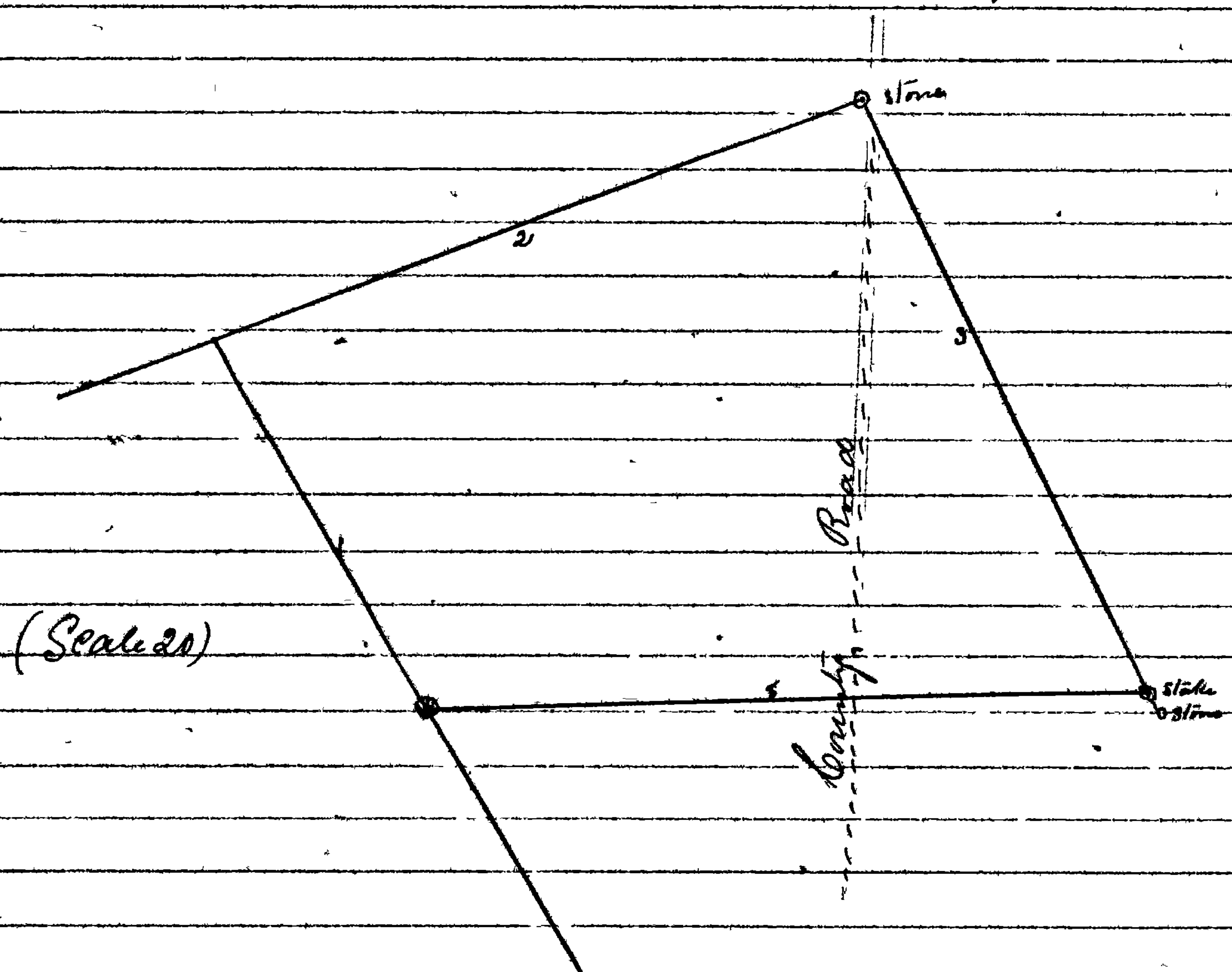


Part of Middle Plantation, which was conveyed by William Horn
 Joshua Horn & Jacob Horn to Aaron Horn by deed dated February 16th
 1814. Beginning at the beginning of said deed it being at the end
 of 98 1/4 ps on the main diagonal line of that part of Middle
 Plantation held by the Horn family in February 1814 at the time of
 passing deed for the several parts and running thence with said
 line (1) N 30° W 57 1/2 ps to intersect the given line of Cocks Orchard
 and running thence (2) N 69° E 84 ps to the beginning stone
 of Cocks Orchard. Thence (3) S 26° E 88 1/2 ps to a stake thence with a
 straight line to the beginning containing 33 acres one Rod and
 thirty perches surveyed and Calculated April 18th 1872.

 It is this 16th day of May A.D. 1872.
 by Me. Nelson Judge of the Circuit Court for Frederick County as a

 Real Estate in the proceedings mentioned in this case and the
 valuation thereof made by them be ratified and confirmed
 on Friday the 29th day of May A.D. 1872 unless cause to the

 a copy of this order be signed on the said Margaret & Ann
 Baker and Joseph H. L. Carty their guardian at least four
