Testimony At the execution of the within Commission issued out of the Circuit Court for Frederick's County sitting as a Court of Equity to me directed and empowering me to examine witnesses in a cause pending in said Court in which said Ann Lloyd D. Durall is Complainant and John Plummer & wife et al are defendants said Cause being No 2907 on the Equity Docket of said Court. I Myself being the standing and duly qualified Commissioner did proceed at my Law Office in the City of Frederick on Sunday the 30th day of July 1860 to take the following depositions to wit: William H. Smith a witness of lawful age produced on the part of the Complainant being duly sworn and examined to Interrogatories filed with the Commissioner and hereunto returned as follows: In the 1st Interrogatory I know all the parties to this suit. In the 2nd Interrogatory I do not know where Mrs. Plummer wife live. Mrs. Nokes and wife live in the District of Columbia. The rest reside in Frederick's County. I think they are all over twenty one year of age. In the 3rd Interrogatory I know the real property named in the Bill and Exhibit C. and it is the property of which Ann Plummer died seized and possessed. In the 4th Interrogatory she is dead I do not know when she died. As being at home she left Mary Margaret & Betty also Mrs. Plummer Noble Dean Edwina Dean. In the 5th Interrogatory I do not know whether she left personal property enough to pay her debts but I think she did not. She left nothing but some household property a few pigs and a horse and Lot. In the 6th Interrogatory I look at the account filed in this case marked Exhibit A. and I believe it to be just and true and I know that if Dursey attends her during her illness. In the 7th Interrogatory I look at the note filed in this case marked Exhibit B. I do not know that the signature is genuine. Also at the same time and place James B. Bryant a witness of lawful age produced on the part of the Complainant being duly sworn and examined to Interrogatories filed and returned as follows: In the 1st Interrogatory I know them all them all except the wives of William Nokes and John Plummer. In the 2nd Interrogatory William Nokes wife live in the District of Columbia. Noble Dean is boating on the canal I do not know where John Plummer resides. The rest are residents of Frederick's County I think they are all over twenty one year of age. In the 3rd Interrogatory I do not know the Real property named in the Bill & Exhibit filed in this case. In the 4th Interrogatory she is dead. I do not know when she died Mrs. Plummer Edwina Dean Noble Dean Catharine & Mary Dean are all that I know. In the 5th Interrogatory I do not know the amounts of the debts but do not think she left personal property enough to pay her debts. In the 6th Interrogatory I answer as to the return.
