

unto you full power and authority in pursuance of the special order in our said Court to assign and appoint a guardian for the aforesaid infants and to take the names of the said infants by such guardian to the said Bill and therefore by comparison that at such certain day and place as you shall think fit you go to said defendants if they cannot conveniently come to you and assign and appoint a guardian for the aforesaid infants and take the names of the said infants by such guardian to the said Bill on such guardian's personal oath upon the Holy Evangelists to be administered by you the said names being distinctly and plainly written and when you shall have so taken the said names you are to send the same filed up under your seal together with your certificate of your having assigned and appointed such guardian as aforesaid by the said Court into our said Court.
