Know all men by these presents that we Daniel Getzendanner and Jonathan Getzendanner of Frederick County in the State of Maryland are held and firmly obliged unto the State of Maryland in the great and full sum of eight hundred dollars Current money to be paid to the said State or its certain attorney to which payment will and truly to be made and done on said day and each of us our and each of our heirs jointly and severally firmly by these presents sealed with our seals and dated the 23rd day of June in the year 1840.

Whereas the above named Daniel Getzendanner was appointed a trustee in and by a decree of Frederick County Court sitting as a Court of Equity made in Case No 1708 Equity between David Parish wife and complainants and David W. Parish & others are defendants. On the conditions of the above obligation is such that if the above named Daniel Getzendanner shall well and faithfully perform the trust reposed in him by the said decree or that may be reposed in him by any future decree in the premises and shall abide any order made by said Court in the premises then the said bond shall be void & be and remain in full force in Law
