To the Honorable Madison Nelson Judge of the Circuit Court for Frederick County sitting as a Court of Equity the petition of Leander McKee and Anna McKee his wife of Washington County in the State of Maryland respectfully shows unto your Honor that Joseph Gabby of said County of Washington in his lifetime made and executed his last will and testament in due form of law to pass real estate and soon after departed this life without having in any manner executed the same and that said last will and testament was duly admitted to probate by the Oprobria Court of Washington County - that said Joseph Gabby in and by his last will and testament amongst other things devised & bequeathed as follows viz "I give and bequeath unto my daughter Eliza for her use and benefit during her natural life with all my property both real and personal and mixed (not herein before devised or disposed of) together with the interest of my bank stock and township stock she shall keep the buildings & fences and repair and after her death I order my said property to be sold at public sale both real personal & mixed
