Sealed with our seals and dated this 21st day of January A.D. 1862

Whereas by a decree of the Circuit Court for Frederick County sitting as a Court of Equity bearing date on the 21st day of January 1862 and passed in a cause pending in said Court on the petition of Leander McKee & Anna McKee his wife the said Grayson Bichelberger was appointed trustee for the purpose therein specified set forth

Now the condition of the above obligation is such that if the above bound Grayson Bichelberger do and shall well & faithfully perform the trust reposed in him by said decree or which may be reposed in him by any future decree or order in the premises then the above obligation shall be void otherwise to be & remain in full force & virtue in law
