And your petitioners further state, that John Hane left the following children, namely Susan E. later married to Whittier, deceased, Christiana L. later married to John M. Hall, Catharine, married to Otho Peck, William L. Hane, and John T. Hane who were all living at the death of said Margaret Hane, & that therefore that your petitioners may get possession of the premises as they are entitled to and that the said real estate may be sold and divided as provided for by the said last will and testament of John Hane dec'd, they pray your Honor to pass an order in the case appointing a trustee to sell the said real estate and account to this Court for the proceeds of such sales and that the same may be distributed to the said children of said John Hane dec'd under the direction of your Honorable Court, to the purposes as provided by the said last will and testament of John Hane, deceased; and that your petitioners may have such further relief as their case may require, And in duty bound.
