

Yth Interrogatory, I look at the paper now produced by me before the Commission, I prepared said paper from the exhibit-
 ing witness to said paper, I saw Conrad brone signed the paper, ^{He says he signed the paper} both for himself and his brother Henry brone, I also saw Jacob Hook
 of Jacob, sign the said paper. The lands described in the said paper on said Exhibit J. V. C. Miller are the same as those described in Exhib-
 it No. 1, filed in this cause, I do not know whether Jacob Hook entered into the possession of said lands - there were buildings on them &
 I do remember that Conrad brone told Hook, he could go into possession at once - I do not know that Hook has paid any
 part of the purchase money, on said lands.

Third Interrogatory, I know Conrad brone, he is dead, He has been dead over a year He left a widow and I have also
 heard that he left several children, but I did not know any of them. The widow and children reside in Frederick County.
 The children are all minors, but I do not know their names.

Yth Interrogatory, I know Jacob Hook; I have understood that he went to the West but I do not know he is dead or not.
 Lastly, I know nothing further. — There being no further testimony and no further time being required for the
 production of witnesses, I have closed this commission and herewith return the same together with Exhibits No.

Articles of Agreement, made this fifth day of April A.D. one thousand eight hundred and fifty-six
 between Conrad brone, and Henry brone, of the first part, of the second part, of the same place of the second part. Whereas, the said par-
 ty of the first part are the owners of certain Lands, which join the Lands of the said party of the
 second part. Now this agreement Witnesseth, that the said party of the first part, for the consideration here-
 inafter named, doth hereby covenant and agree to sell and convey, by a good deed, along of all encumbrances, all
 the following described Lands with the water, water rights & thereon, thereunto belonging, Beginning at and
 where said Hook's line fence joins the meadow of the said brone, on the West side of the Petrusville road,
 and running from thence to the Petrusville road to the center of the same, at the corner of said brone's lot on the
 South East corner thereof, then with center of said Petrusville road, and along with the same, to the upper end
 of the aforesaid meadow, nearly opposite Peter Petrus stable, where the fence comes up to the road from
 the direction of the said Hook's Land, thence with a line to the beginning, running with a fence as is now being
