At the request of Michael Zimmerman and others the following Deed was recorded October 31<sup>st</sup> 1866

This Indenture made this 28<sup>th</sup> day of January in the year of our Lord one thousand, eight hundred and fifty one, between Elias Grove of Frederick County in the State of Maryland of the one part, and Michael Zimmerman, trustee of the German Reform Church, Charles H. Burkhardt, trustee of the Presbyterian Church, Cornelius Staley trustee of the United Brethren Church, William P. Preston, trustee of the Methodist Episcopal Church, and Elias Grove, trustee of the Lutheran Church of the other: all of the County and State aforesaid, Witnesses, that the said Elias Grove for and in consideration of the regard and esteem he has for the cause of Religion, and the sum of one dollar current money to him in hand paid by the said parties of the second part, trustees aforesaid, before the sealing of these presents, the receipt whereof he the said Elias Grove doth hereby acknowledge, hath granted, bargained, sold, aliened, conveyed and confirmed, and by these presents doth grant, bargain, sell, alien, convey and confirm unto them the said parties of the second part, trustees as aforesaid, all that Lot or parcel of ground, lying and being in the County and State aforesaid. Beginning for said Lot or parcel of ground at a stone standing at a Laurel bush on the Commons, it being the end of the second line of a tract of land called "Chestnut Level" conveyed by Frederick Baker to Peter Wolf by deed bearing date the fourth day of November Eighteen hundred and nine, and running thence North Eighty seven degrees West Eighteen perches to intersect the road leading from Frederick to Hamburg, and then South thirty two and a half degrees East seven perches on the said road, then North Eighty six and a half degrees East fourteen perches, then by a strait to the beginning, containing one half an acre of land; together with all and singular the rights, privileges and appurtenances thereunto belonging or in any wise appertaining, and all the estate, right
