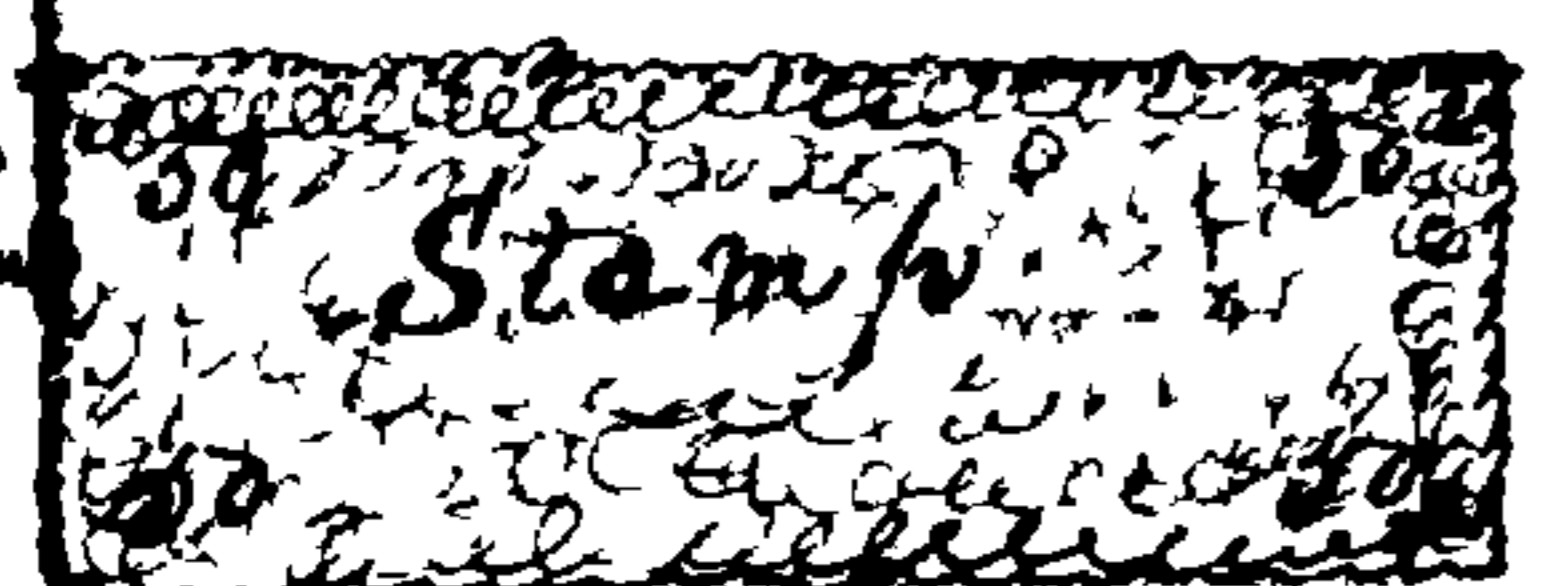

The Bill of Complaint of Christian Harman and Mary Susan Harman
 his wife, George W. Stottmeyer, and Rebecca Stottmeyer his wife, Sabelian
 Harman widow of George Harman, Moses L. Hurley and Mahala Hurley his
 wife, Benjamin Shuff and Sarah A. Shuff his wife, Wilson Stottmeyer and Catharine
 Stottmeyer his wife, of Frederick County State of Maryland, of James C. Stottmeyer
 and Mary Jane Stottmeyer his wife of Washington County State of Maryland, of Joshua
 Lane and Catharine Lane his wife of the State of Pennsylvania, of Nelson Stottmeyer
 and Sarah A. C. Stottmeyer his wife of the State of Ohio, respectfully shows to your Honor
 that a certain Hannah Stottmeyer late of Frederick County State of Maryland died

 a daughter, now the wife of Benjamin Shuff, Daniel Stottmeyer, William H.
 Stottmeyer, Nelson Stottmeyer - And Samuel C. Himes, Hannah C. Himes
 Elizabeth Ann Himes, Eliza A. Himes, Amanda M. Himes, and Martha Ellen
