 dead, that she died intestate about two years ago, in Frederick County, Maryland ~ To the 3^d Sub:
 That Hannah Stottlemeyer left the following children and Grand-children, namely;
 Mary Susan, married to Christian Harman, who resides in Frederick County, Maryland;
 George W. Stottlemeyer, who resides in Frederick County, Maryland, James C. Stottlemeyer,
 who resides in Frederick County, Maryland; Catharine, married to Joshua Lane, who resides
 in the State of Pennsylvania; Nelson Stottlemeyer, who resides in the State of Ohio; Sabiana
 married to George Harman, who resides in Frederick County, Maryland, Mahala, married
 to Moses C. Hurley, who resides in the State of Maryland; Sarah Ann, married to Benja-
 min Shuff, who resides in Frederick County, Maryland; Daniel Stottlemeyer, who resides in
 the State of Ohio; William H. Stottlemeyer, who resides in the State of Ohio, and Nelson Stott-
 lemyer who resides in the State of Ohio; all children and adults above the age of twenty one years,
 and Hannah C. Himes, Samuel C. Himes, Elizabeth A. Himes, Eliza A. Himes, Amanda W.
 Himes, and Martha C. Himes, who are all infants under the age of twenty one years, and all
