

said Jacob Snurr was seized and possessed of one undivided ninth part of the real estate mentioned in the proceedings in this cause, and that therefore a portion of the purchase money arising from the sale of said real estate made in pursuance of a decree passed in this cause, belongs to the said Jacob Snurr, which as your petitioner is informed, he is unable to reach by any proceeding in a Court of Law.

It is the end therefore that the said judgment may be paid, and that your petitioner may have such further or other relief as his case may require; May it please your Honors to grant unto your petitioner an order of this Court instructing and directing the Auditor to audit to your petitioner the amount of money which shall be ascertained to be due and coming to the said Jacob Snurr or so much thereof as may be necessary for the payment of the said judgment and the interest due thereon, and the balance, if any, to him the said Jacob Snurr.
