Bill of Complaint



No. 3307 Equity
 To the Hon Madison Nelson Circuit Judge of the Fourth
 Judicial Circuit of the State of Maryland sitting in the Circuit
 Court for Frederick County as a Court of Equity.

The Bill of Complaint of Ann C. Wolfe of Frederick County State of Md.
 filed in behalf of herself and all other Creditors of John Keizer late of Frederick
 County dec'd, who may come in and contribute to the expenses of this suit; respectfully
 shows to your Honor, that the said John Keizer was seized in fee of a valuable real
 estate situate in the County and State aforesaid, and which said real estate is par-
 ticularly described in the Deeds of John Keizer Sr. and Ann Keizer his wife to said
 John Keizer Jr and from Stephen R. Core and wife to said John Keizer Jr which
 will more fully and at large appear by reference to said deeds; Copies of which are
 herewith Exhibited marked Exhibits Nos. 1 & 2, which your Complainant prays,
 together with all other Exhibits hereinafter produced, may be taken as part of
 this her Bill of Complaint.

Your Complainant further states that the said John Keizer was indebted to
 your Complainant by his single bill dated on the first day of April Eighteen
 hundred and sixty four in the sum of One hundred and forty dollars with
 interest from date, and that the whole of said sum of money with interest from
 the first day of April Eighteen hundred and sixty five is still due and owing
 to your Complainant, all of which will appear by reference to said Single Bill
 herewith Exhibited marked Exhibit No. 3.

Your Complainant further states that the said John Keizer was indebted
 to the Frederick Town Savings Institution by his promissory note dated March
 the tenth Eighteen hundred and sixty five, in the sum of Sixteen hundred dollars
 and to secure the payment of said note, did on the thirteenth day of March Eighteen
 hundred and sixty five, execute his Mortgage conveying the real Estate described in
 Exhibit No. 1 to said Frederick Town Savings Institution, except the land heretofore
 sold and conveyed by said John Keizer and Ann Keizer his wife, to John Wolfe Sr.
 and to the Methodist Episcopal Church mentioned in said Mortgage, all of which will
 fully appear by reference to said Mortgage, a copy of which is herewith Exhibited
 marked Exhibit No. 4.

Your Complainant further states that the said John Keizer died sometime in
 in the month of March Eighteen hundred and sixty six, having previously executed
