Decree

Ann B. Wolf No 3308 Equity In the Circuit Court for Frederick County sitting as a Court of Equity October Term 1866

The above Cause standing ready for a hearing and being submitted, the Bill answers and Exhibits, depositions and all other proceedings were by the Court read and considered. It is therefore, this 18th day of November in the year Eighteen hundred and sixty six, by the Honorable Madison Nelson Circuit Judge for the Fourth Judicial Circuit of the State of Maryland, and by the Authority of the Circuit Court for Frederick County, as a Court of Equity, adjudged ordered, and decreed, that the land and premises mentioned in these proceedings be sold, and that Ann Kuzer of Frederick County, be, and she is hereby appointed a Trustee to make the said sales, and that the course and manner of her proceeding shall be as follows she shall first file in the Clerk's Office of this Court a bond to the State of Maryland, executed by herself with a surety, or sureties to be approved by the Court, or the Clerk thereof, in the penalty of Twenty thousand
