This Mortgage made this Eighth day of December in the year Eighteen hundred and sixty six, by Writhe Lowe of Frederick City, Frederick County in the State of Maryland.

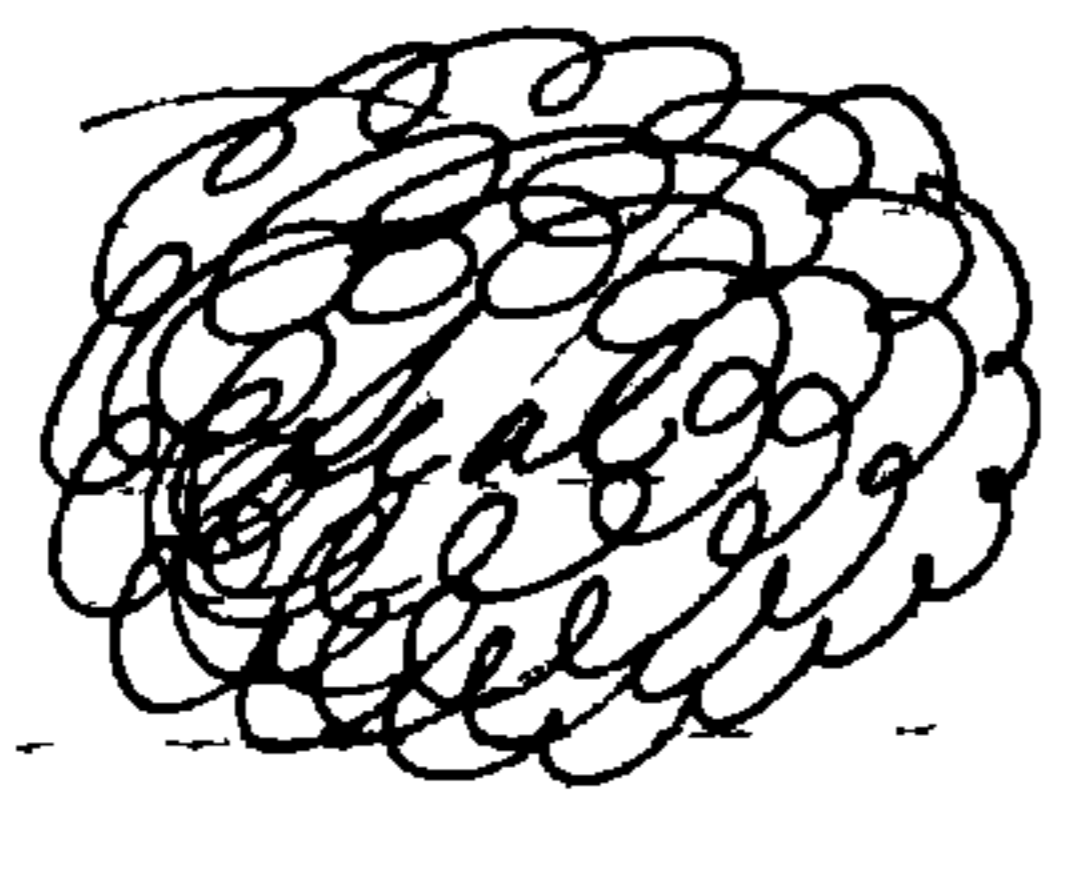
Witnesseth that I Writhe Lowe by my single bill dated on the Eighth day of December in the year Eighteen hundred and sixty six, and payable one year after date, with interest from date, payable annually, stand indebted to Ezra Slifer of the County and State aforesaid, in the sum of Two hundred dollars (\$200.00) and to secure the payment of the said sum of Two Hundred dollars, with the interest thereon annually, according to the tenor and effect of the single bill aforesaid, I the said Writhe Lowe do grant in fee simple, unto the said Ezra Slifer all that Lot or part of a Lot of ground and premises (being Lot No. 154 on the plat of Frederickstown) situate lying and being on the North side of East South Street Frederick Maryland, and it being the same Lot of ground and premises which was conveyed to the said Writhe Lowe and William Lowe by deed from Philip Reeb and Rebecca d St Reeb his wife, bearing date on the 28<sup>th</sup> day of April A.D. 1846, and recorded in Liber N. B. S. No. 3 folio 244 &c, Also all that Lot or parcel of ground and premises, situate, lying, and being on the North side of East South Street, Frederick City Maryland, being the same Lot of ground and premises conveyed to the aforesaid Writhe Lowe by deed from Henry Campbell and Catherine Campbell his wife bearing date on the 14<sup>th</sup> day of October A.D. 1857, and Recorded in Liber Ed. No. 10 folio 637, both of said Records being Land Records of Frederick County, as by reference thereto being had will more fully and at large appear. Provided, that if I the said Writhe Lowe shall pay to the said Ezra Slifer on the Eighth day of December in the year Eighteen hundred and sixty seven, the sum of Two Hundred dollars, with interest thereon, payable annually according to the tenor and effect of the single bill above recited, then this Mortgage shall be void.

And the said Writhe Lowe covenants that she will pay the aforesaid Money, and she further covenants that in default of payment the said Ezra Slifer may enter; Provided that in default of payment the said Writhe Lowe shall possess the premises
