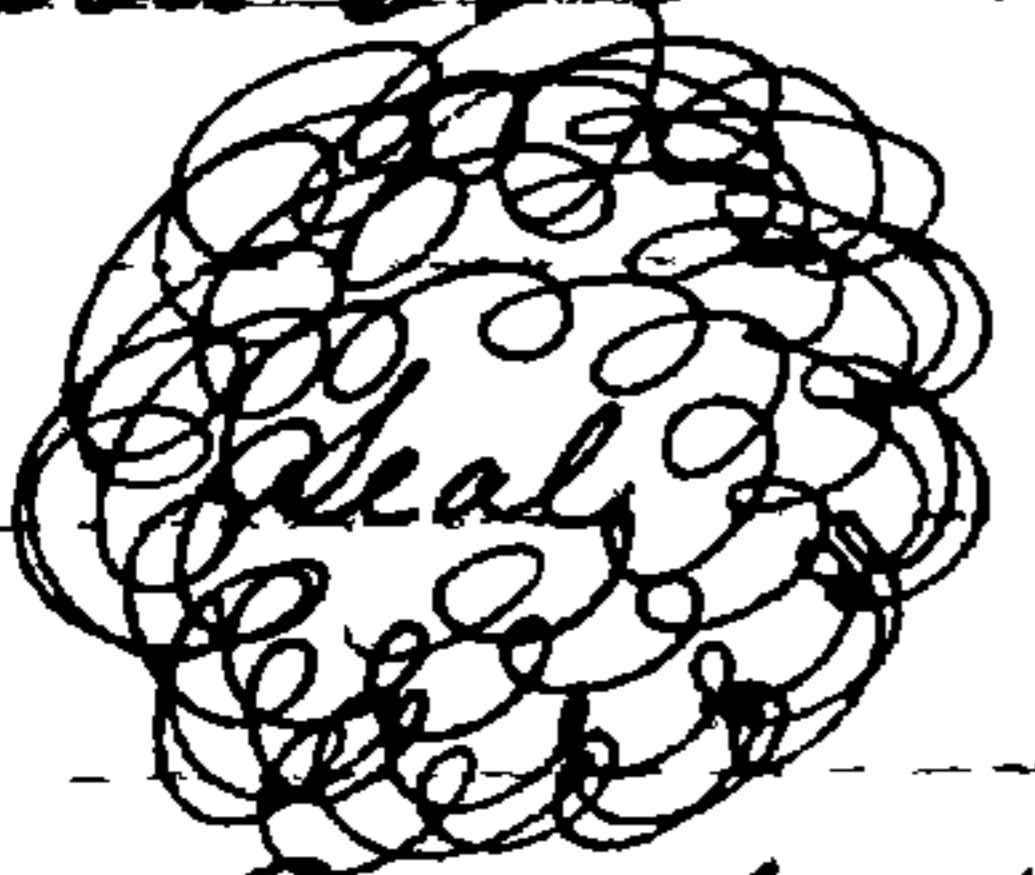

In the Name of God, Amen!

Henry M. Snyder of Frederick County in the State of Maryland being sick and weak in body, but of sound and disposing mind, memory and understanding, considering the certainty of death, and the uncertainty of the time thereof, and being desirous to settle my worldly affairs, and thereby be the better prepared to leave this world when it shall please God to call me hence, do therefore make and publish this my last Will and Testament, in manner and form following, that is to say

First and principally, I commit my soul into the hands of Almighty God and my body to the Earth to be decently buried, at the discretion of my Executor hereinafter named, and after my debts and funeral charges are paid, I devise and bequeath as follows, to wit: Item 1st, I give and devise to my dear wife Harriet Ann Snyder during her natural life my house and lot of land thereto attached, on which I now reside, being on the North side of the Street in New Market, and after the death of my said wife, I give and bequeath the said house and lot of land to my children share and share alike. I also give and bequeath to my said wife the sum of One thousand dollars for her support and maintenance. Item 2nd I give and devise to my son Oliver P. Snyder my house and lot of land adjoining my Store Room in New Market to him his heirs and assigns forever in fee simple, I also give and devise to my said son Oliver P. Snyder my said store room and the lot of land thereto belonging, to him his heirs and assigns forever in fee simple, I also give and bequeath to my said son Oliver P. Snyder my half of the store goods now on my said store, for which goods, my said son must pay to my daughters Anna Snyder and Emma Snyder the sum of Seven hundred and forty dollars. Item 3rd I give and devise to my two sons Henry M. Snyder and Clarence Snyder, and to my daughter Fanny Snyder, my four acre lot of land situated near the Town of New Market to them, their heirs and assigns forever in fee simple. Item 4th I give and
