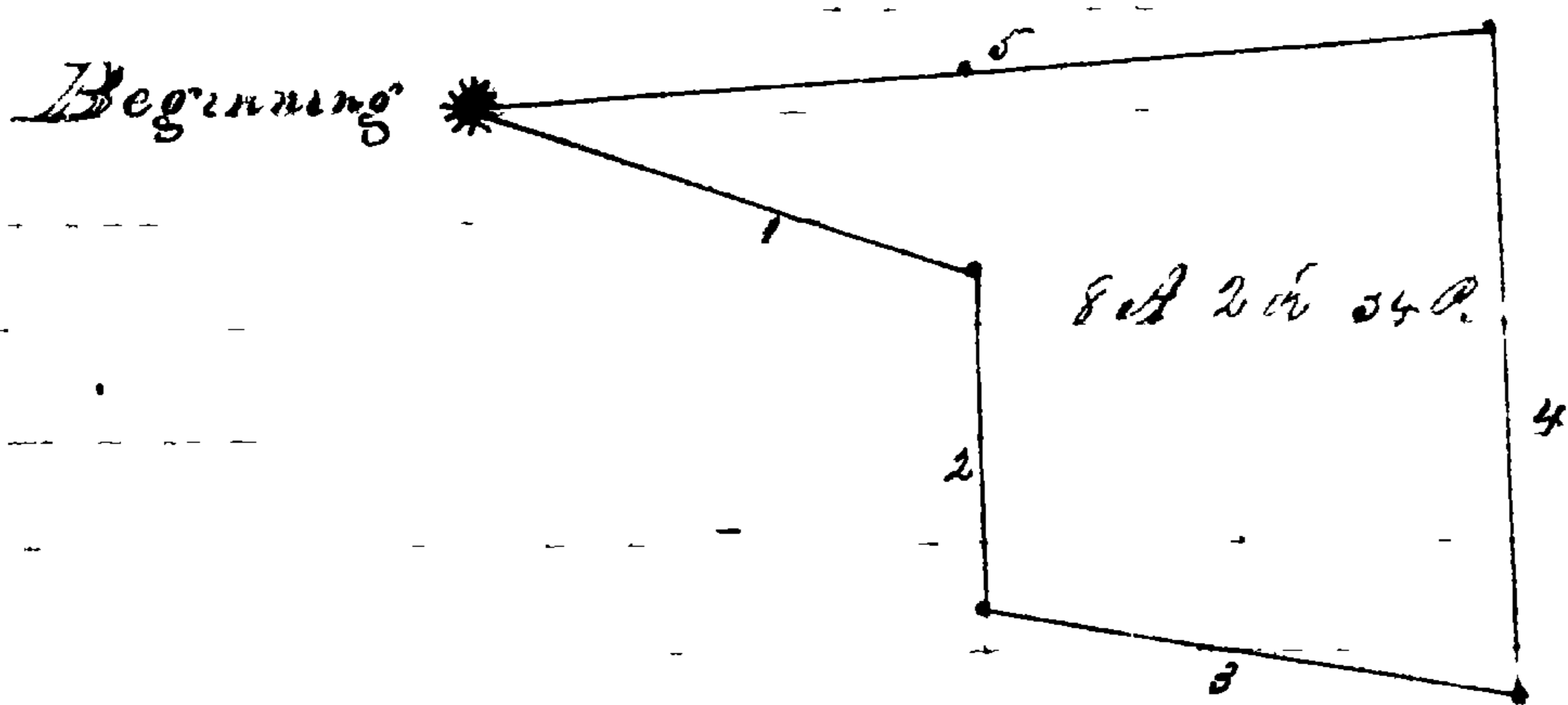

Morris' land (4) S. 86 1/2° E. 49 3/4 ps. to a planted stone; thence (5) N. 83° E. 24 3/4 ps. thence (6) N. 33° E. 3 ps. to a planted stone; thence (7) S. 34° E. 129 3/4 ps. to a planted stone, thence (8) S. 81° W. 152 ps. to a stone standing on the sixth line of Leeds Content; thence (9) N. 24° W. 6 1/2 ps. to a stone No. 6. thence with a straight line to the beginning, containing 101 1/2 Acres -
