
First and principally I commit my soul into the hands of Almighty God, and my body to the Earth, to be decently buried, at the discretion of my Executors and Executor herein after named, and after my debts and funeral charges are paid, I devise and bequeath as follows. ~

Imprimis, I give and bequeath to my beloved wife Elizabeth Stockman, all my Estate, Real, Personal and Mixed of whatever kind soever, for and during her widowhood (or natural life) to be possessed and used by her, at her discretion for the support of herself and family during the time aforesaid, but in case she may think proper and do marry again, then I give her one eighth part of my Estate, that is to say, an equal division between her and my children hereinafter named, and no more. ~

Item, At the death, or marriage, of my said wife, I give, bequeath and devise, to my sons by name, Julian Maryan, John, Christian, Elizabeth, Catherine, Polly Margaret, and Barbara Ann Rebecca, all my said estate that may remain, or held and possessed by my said wife at the time of her death, or marriage (except the one eighth above mentioned, in case of her marriage, to be equally divided among them share and share alike, to them and their heirs forever ~

And lastly, I do hereby constitute and appoint my dear wife Elizabeth Stockman Executor, and my son Christian Stockman executor of this my last Will and Testament proving and annulling all former Wills by me heretofore made, ratifying and confirming this and now other to be my last Will and Testament. ~

In testimony whereof I have hereunto set my hand and affixed my seal this 14th day of June in the year of our Lord One thousand eight hundred and fifty ~

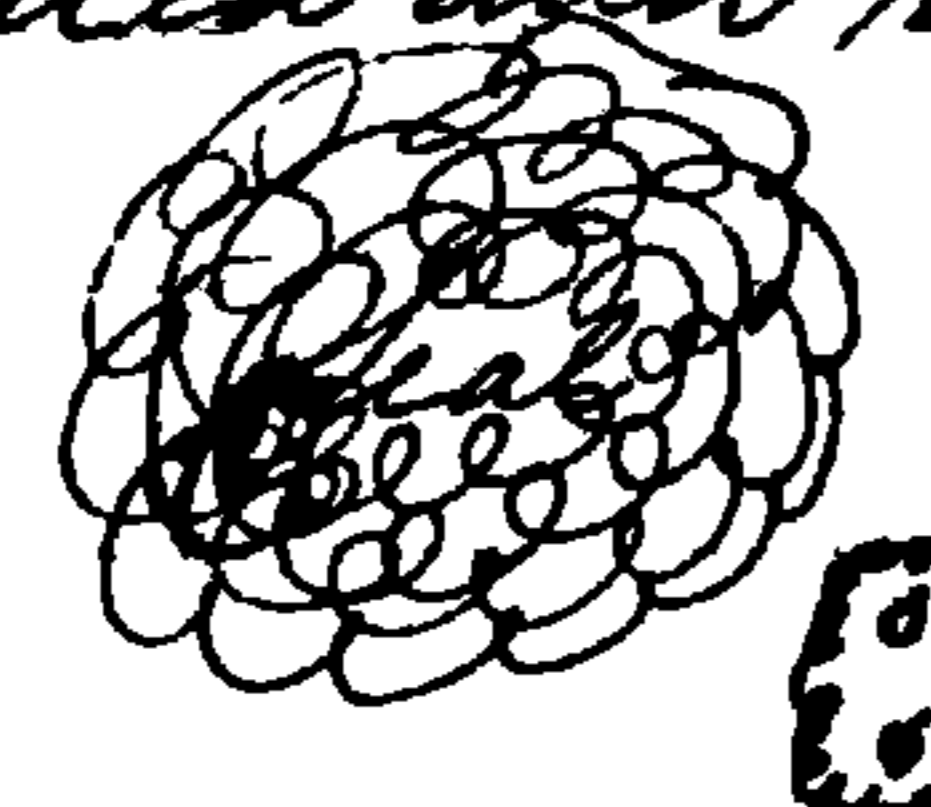
