

case. That the said John Stockman applied for the benefit of Insolvent Laws of this State in the year 1837, and Wm. B. Taylor was appointed his trustee to whom he conveyed all his property. The Bill charges that said real estate is not susceptible of division or partition among the parties without loss and injury to the parties entitled, but that it would be for the interest and advantage of all the parties, infants as well as adults that said property should be sold, and the proceeds divided among the parties according to their respective interests. That all the aforesaid parties are adults, except the said Philip Smith and Daniel H. Smith who are under twenty one years of age; and they all reside in and are Frederick County, except said Thomas W. Smith and wife who live in Washington County Maryland and the said Solomon Montgomery and Mary Ann and her husband, whose name is unknown to complainants, who reside in the State of Illinois. ~

It is therefore this 14th day of June A.D. 1867, ordered that the complainants by causing a copy of this order, to be inserted in some newspaper published in Frederick County, once a week for four successive weeks before the 23rd day of July A.D. 1867, give notice to the said Solomon Montgomery and Mary Ann his wife, Daniel H. Smith and the said Barbara Ann and her husband, whose names are unknown to the complainants, said absent defendants, of the object and substance of this Bill, and warn them to appear in this Court, in person or by solicitor, on or before the 23rd day of October A.D. 1867, to answer the premises, and show cause if any they have, why a decree ought not to pass as prayed. ~

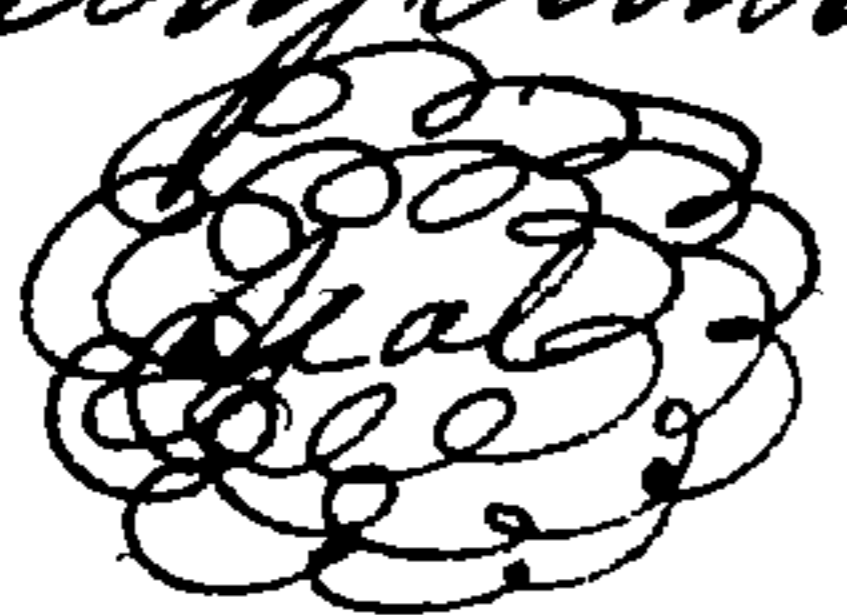
