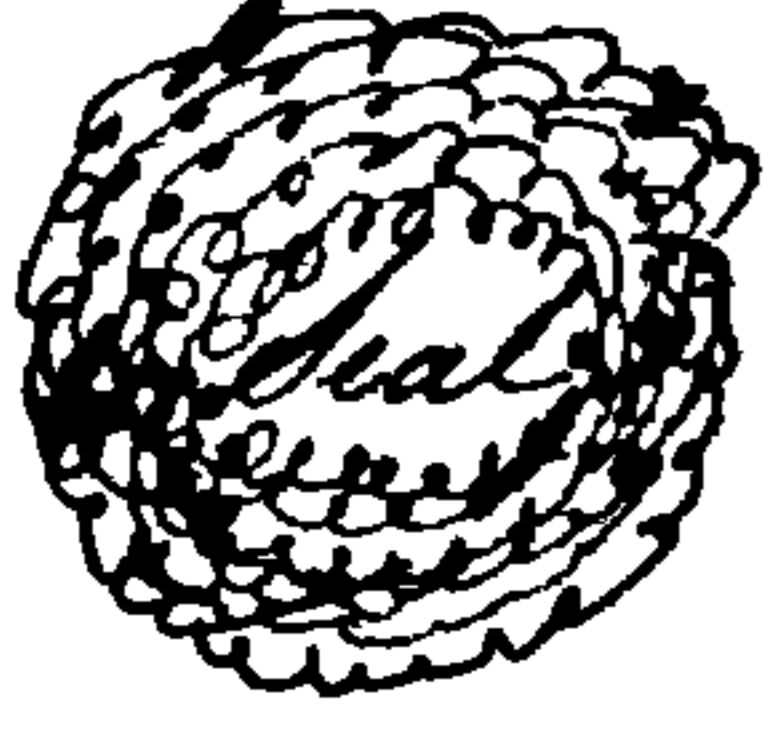


Subpoena

Pearson, of Carroll County, Greeting. You are hereby commanded that all excuses set apart, you personally appear before the Judge of the Circuit Court for Frederick County, sitting as a Court of Equity, to be held at the Court House in Frederick town, in and for said County, on the First Monday of January next to answer the Bill of Complaint of Leyceus N. Phillips, Executor of the Last Will and Testament of Noah Phillips, deceased, against you in our said Court exhibited, and so forth.

Hereof, fail you not, as you will answer the contrary at your peril. Witness the Honourable Madison Nelson, Judge of our said Court, the 19th day of October 1863, Issued the 14th day of December 1863

Leyceus N. Phillips Executor of the last Will & Testament of Noah Phillips deceased Charles Wolfe & Others

No. 3131 Equity ~ In the Circuit Court for Frederick County in Equity ~ The object of the present suit is to procure a decree for a sale of certain Mortgaged premises in Frederick County State of Maryland, which were

on the seventh day of April Eighteen hundred and forty eight Mortgaged by Isaac Wright and Mary Wright his wife to Noah Phillips, now dead, of whose Will the complainant is Executor ~

The Bill states that on the seventh day of April Eighteen hundred and forty eight, the said Isaac Wright and Mary Wright his wife, conveyed certain real Estate, which is particularly described in the Bill and the Copy of the deed of Mortgage accompanying it, unto the said Noah Phillips in his life time, to secure the payment of the sum of fourteen hundred dollars with interest from date, in four instalments of Three hundred and fifty dollars each, payable in two, three, four, and five years after the date, with interest from date - and due and owing from the said Isaac Wright to the said Noah Phillips has recently died, leaving a last Will and Testament of which he appointed the Complainant the Executor, who has proved the same, and obtained letters testamentary thereon ~ That Isaac Wright and Mary Wright his wife, have conveyed by deed the said Mortgaged premises to Abraham Wolfe ~ That Abraham Wolfe and Sarah Wolfe his wife, by deed have conveyed part of said Mortgaged Premises, to John Agnew & Raphael Parboe, and that said Noah Phillips by deed executed to said Agnew & Parboe has released that portion of said Mortgaged premises conveyed to them, from the lien of his Mortgage thereon, that Isaac C. Pearson is now in possession of the Mortgaged premises, claiming title thereto by contract of sale, made either with Isaac Wright, or said Abraham Wolfe, and has no conveyance for the same ~

The Bill further states that Abraham Wolfe died in the month of October, Eighteen hundred and sixty three, leaving the following children, his heirs at Law, to wit:
