This Mortgage made this Twenty fifth day of March in the year Eighteen hundred and Sixty five by Christopher Cole and Cyrenia R Cole his wife Witnesses that in consideration of the sum of One hundred and fifty dollars, with interest thereon from the date hereof, now due from the said Christopher Cole, and Cyrenia Cole his wife to John R Mills, do the grant unto the said John R Mills, all that lot and parcel of Land situated in Frederick County and State of Maryland aforesaid, which was conveyed to him the said Christopher Cole by deed bearing date this 25th day of March in the year Eighteen hundred and Sixty five, from Ephraim Hedgeley to the said Christopher Cole, being parts of tracts of Land called "Father's Left," and part of a tract called "Difficulty" - Beginning for the first parcel hereby granted, at a stone planted at the end of the fifth line of said parcel of Land, and running thence with and bounding on the outlines thereof two courses, South thirty four degrees West sixteen and a quarter perches to a stone planted, South twenty nine and a half degrees East, nine and a half perches to a stone; then by lines of divisions North thirty five and three quarter degrees East twenty one perches and nine tenth perches to a stone, North sixty three and a half degrees West, nine perches to the place of beginning, Containing one acre of Land. Beginning for the second parcel, hereby granted, at a stone planted at the end of nine and a half perches on the seventh line as stated in the deed made by Adam Markel & Casper Davelles dated on the 20th day of November in the 1807; and running thence with and bounding on said line South twenty nine and a half degrees East twenty four and three quarter perches to a stone, then by lines of Division, North thirty six and three quarter degrees East, thirty six perches to a stone, North sixty two and a half degrees N. twenty three perches to a stone
