

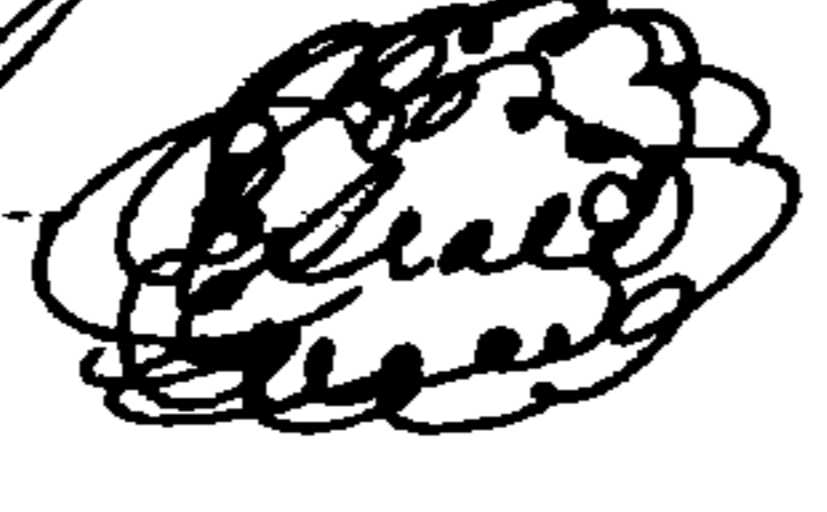

Krammer died intestate on or about the third day of December Eighteen hundred and sixty six, and that letters of Administration on the personal estate of said Frederick W. Krammer were granted by the Orphan's Court for Frederick County, to John A. Krammer and William B. Krammer who have filed their approved bond and entered upon their duties. ~ That said Frederick W.
