This Mortgage made this 29th day of January Eighteen hundred and Sixty two by Robert Annan, Witnesseth that the said Robert Annan by his note duly executed, bearing date the 29th day of January 1862 stands bound unto Andrew Annan in the sum of Eighteen hundred and eighty six dollars and twenty nine cents, with interest thereon, and payable one year after date thereof as by said note more fully appear ~ Witnesseth that in Consideration of the said sum of Eighteen hundred and Eighty six dollars and twenty nine cents with interest thereon from the date thereof, owing by the said Robert Annan to the said Andrew Annan, all three tracts or part of tracts of land lying and being in Frederick County and State of Maryland, as follows; One tract of land adjoining the Hagerstown road, and the home tract of the said Robert Annan called the "Stony Field" containing thirteen Acres of Land more or less, one tract of land containing twelve acres of land more or less, lying between Robert Annan's home tract and James H.
