Sustaining Exceptions

Joshua Motter & Others vs Andrew Annan & others

No. 3313 Equity ~  
In the Circuit Court for Frederick County  
Sitting as a Court of Equity.  
May Term 1868 ~

The questions and matters in dispute between Andrew Annan and David Gamble arising on the exceptions filed to the ratification of the audit and to the Claims of David Gamble therein, having by agreement of the parties filed in this case, been referred to the arbitrament of Richard H. Marshall, Joseph M. Palmer and William J. Ross Esquires, whose arbitrament and award should be final and conclusive when filed here-in, and the said Arbitrators having filed herein their award, wherein they do award and determine that there was due to said David Gamble on Claim No. 2. in said Audit on 5<sup>th</sup> day of June 1867. the sum of One thousand & twenty one dollars and six cents, instead of Fifteen hundred and fifty seven dollars and sixteen cents as therein allowed: It is therefore this 22<sup>nd</sup> day of June 1868. ordered by the Court that the award filed herein, be, and the same is hereby finally ratified and enforced and that the exceptions filed by Andrew Annan to the Audit, and the allowance of Claim No. 2 therein to David Gamble be and they are hereby sustained and ruled good, and that the case is hereby referred back to the Auditor to state a new account, wherein he shall charge the Trustees with the sum allowed to David Gamble on the foregoing Audit. ~

He shall then Audit said sum in conformity with the award filed in this case, and that the costs of the exceptions and of the new Audit be paid by said David Gamble out of the amount audited to him. ~
