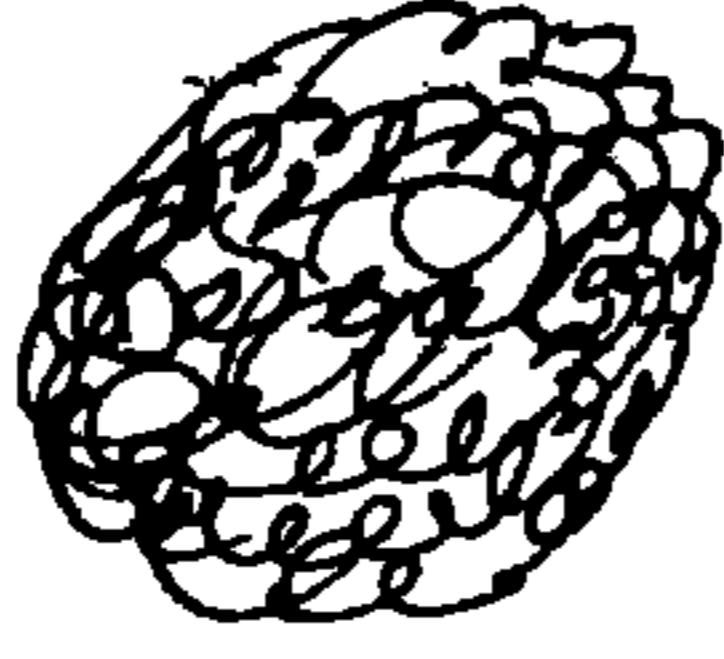

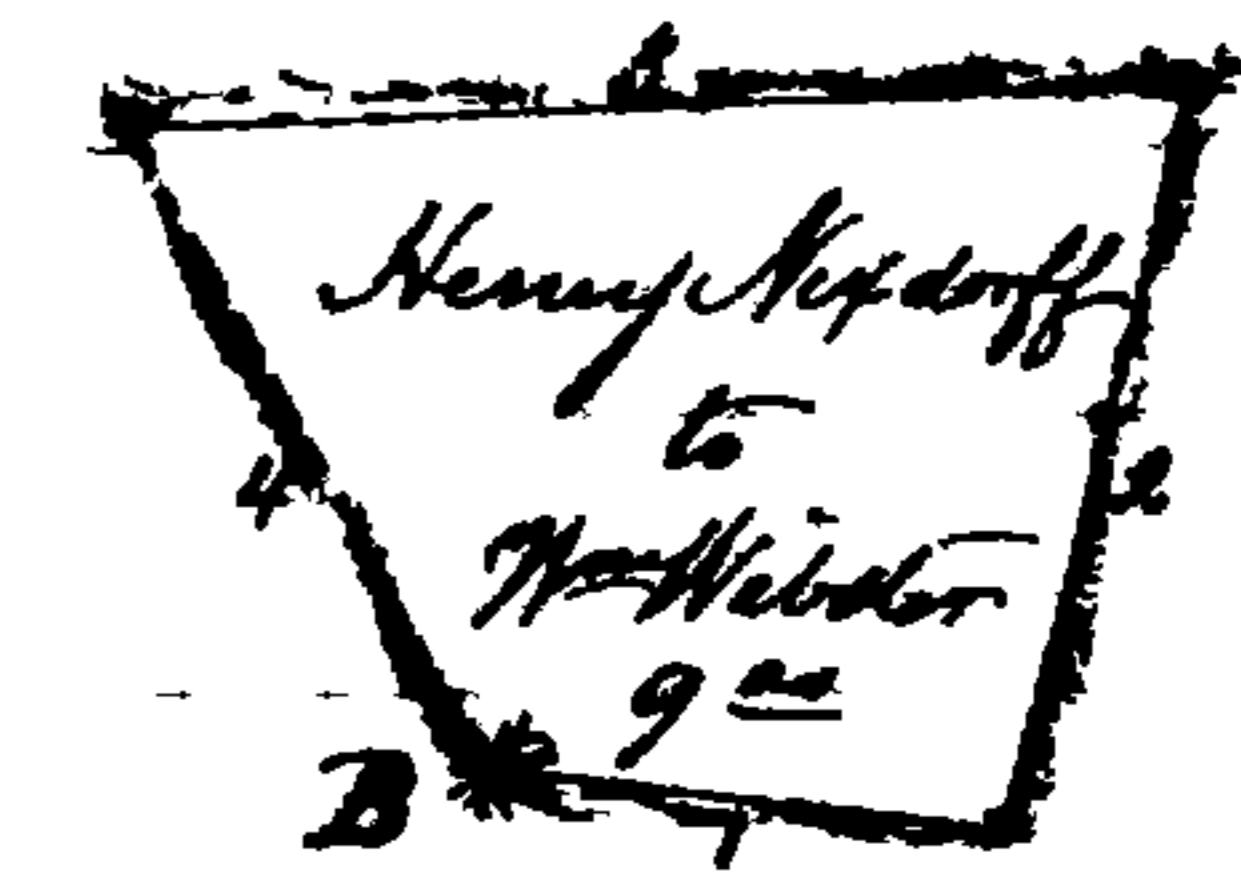
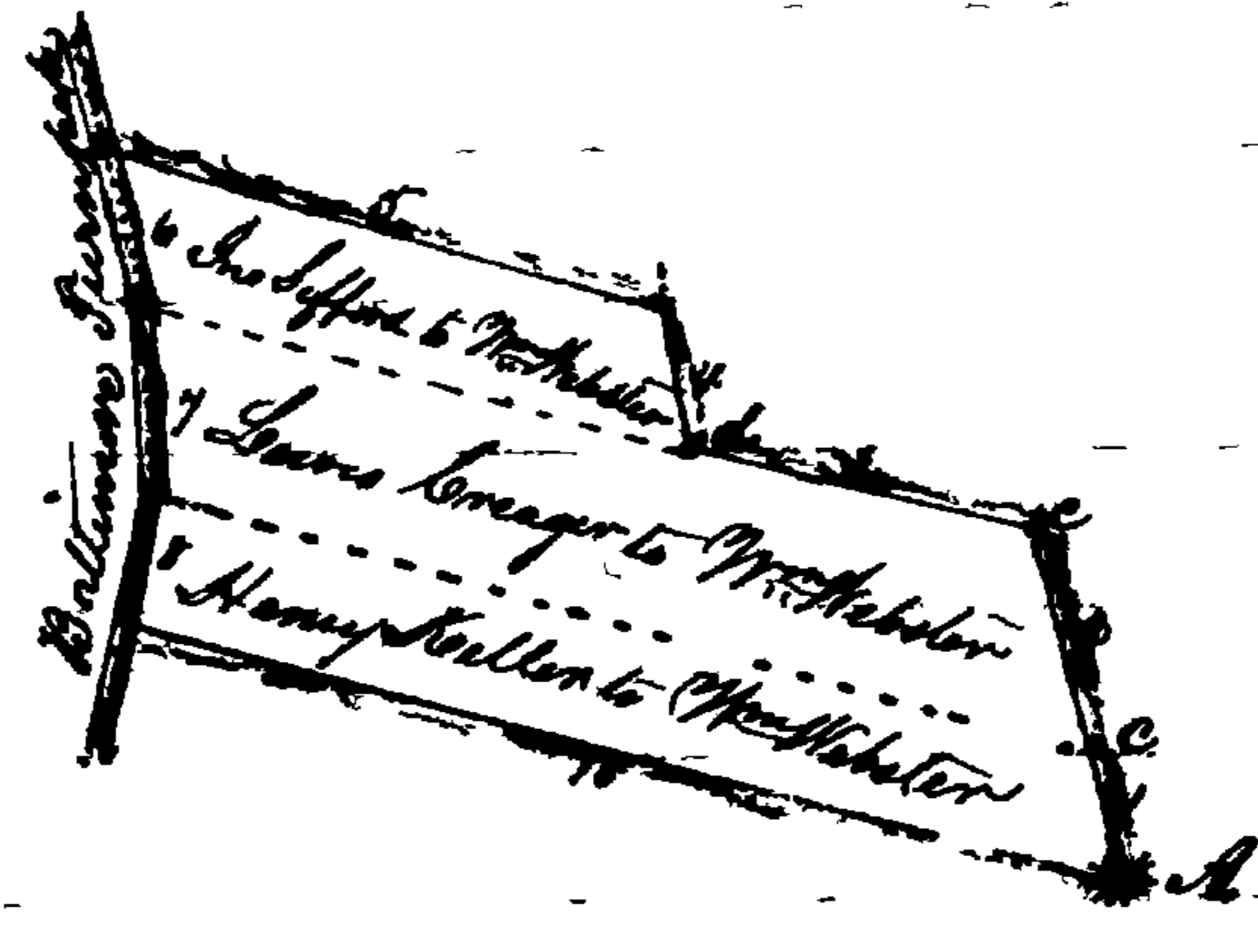

Scale of 40 ps to an inch

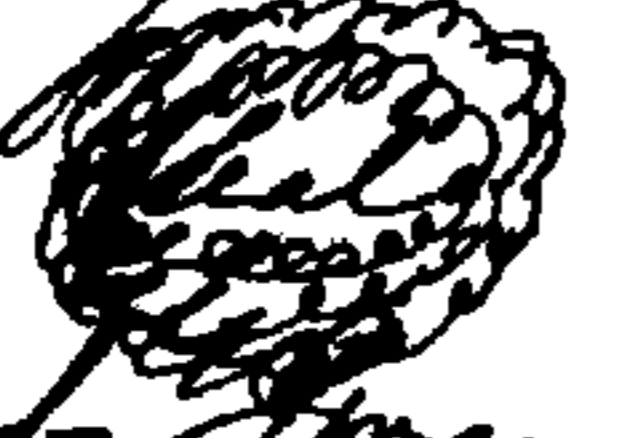
Explanation

- A represents the beginning of three parcels, included within one general outline and runs with the lines numbered 1, 2, 3, 4, 5, 6, 7, 8, 9, 10, home to A.
- C represents the beginning of the parcel, deeded by Lewis Koenig to W. Webster the 6th of March 1822
- C also represents the beginning of the parcel, deeded to H. Keller to W. Webster the 22nd of September 1825
- d represents the beginning of the parcel, deeded by John Shufford to W. Webster the of
- B represents the beginning of the parcel, deeded by Henry Koenig to W. Webster the 28th of April 1826 and runs with the lines 1, 2, 3, 4 home to B. 22nd 1868 - per Tho. H. O'Neal
