- 1st Int: Are you or not acquainted with the parties to this suit or either and which of them? If yes, how long have you known them and each of them?
- 2nd Int: Are you or not, acquainted with the children of Thomas Webster the Petitioner in this cause? If yes, State their names, ages and present places of residence? And if any are married, which of them, and to whom? And are, or are not said children now living?
- 3rd Int: Did or did not, John B Webster the brother of said Petitioner and Co. Trustee under the Will of William Webster deceased, ever enter into possession of the lands devised to said Trustee - And did he or not assist in the support of the widow of said Trustee? If no, state fully your knowledge herein.
- 4th Int: Do you or not know whether the said John B Webster ever executed the trusts reposed in him by the will of William Webster? And if not, state if you know why he did not - state also if you know whether the said John B Webster lives in the State of Maryland or not.
- 5th Int: Do you or not know the widow of William Webster late of Frederick County? If yes, Is she dead or alive? If dead, when and where did she die?
