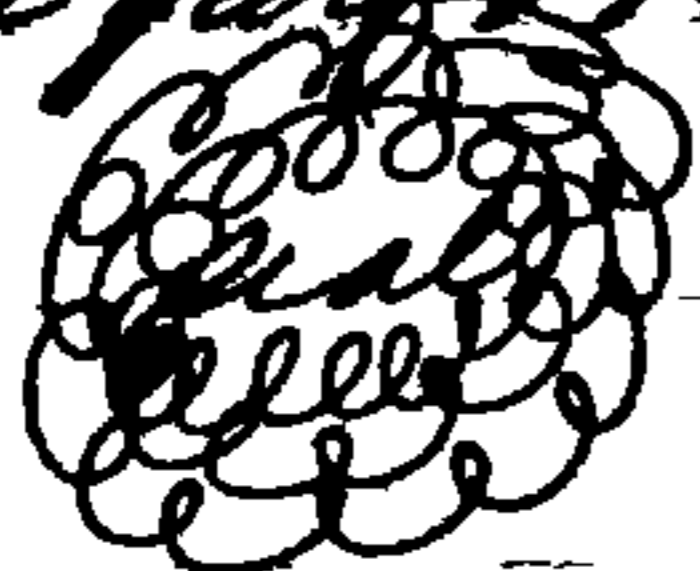

Eichelberger Register of Wills for Frederick County do hereby certify and attest that on the 16th day of January 1837 Letters of Administration in the will annexed were granted by me to Alfred F. Brungle in the Estate of Jacob Brungle late of Frederick County deceased, the said Alfred F. Brungle having given Bond with Nicholas Brungle and Samuel Duer sureties in the sum of \$10,000 current money for the due performance of his said Administration.

I also return as a part of this Commission, papers marked Exhibit A. Exhibit G. M. E. and Paper G. H. filed with me by the solicitor of the Complainant.
