following Deed is recorded the 10th day of August 1838

This Indenture made this tenth day of August in the year of our Lord
Eighteen hundred and thirty eight, between George Kestro Sr, and Catharine Kestro
his wife of Frederick County in the State of Maryland of the one part, and Daniel
Hildebrand of the said County and State aforesaid of the other part, witnesseth
that for and in consideration of the sum of four hundred and forty dollars
current money by the said Daniel Hildebrand to the said George Kestro Sr
in hand paid at and before the sealing and delivery of these presents the receipt
of which he doth hereby acknowledge, and himself content and also Catharine
Kestro wife of said Kestro doth acknowledge and herself content, have granted
bargained, sold, aliened, enfeoffed and confirmed and conveyed, and by these
presents do grant, bargain, sell, alien, enfeoff and confer unto the said Daniel
Hildebrand his heirs and assigns forever, a certain tract or parcel of land
lying and being in the County aforesaid, which will more fully appear by
reference of deed from David F. Schaeffer to George Kestro Sr, dated on the 15th day
of February in the year Eighteen hundred and thirty five, and recorded in
Liber D.S. No. 48 folios 166 and 167, one of the Land Records of Frederick County
Court, being lot No 9 part the Resurvey of Heffner's Fancy, and bounded and
described therein, as follows: Beginning for said Lot No 9 at a stone planted
at the end of the first line of Lot No 8, assigned to Benjamin Heffner and running
thence S 47^o 49' W 97^o 7/8 feet to a stone, thence N 36^o W 90^o 1/2 feet to a stone,
in the first line of lot No 8, thence with N 48 3/4^o E 23 feet to a stone, thence N 24^o E 29 7/8
feet to a stone at the end of the second line of Lot No 8, thence with it reversed S 36^o
E 104 1/2 feet to the beginning, containing 28 Acres of Land more or less, Together
with all and singular the appurtenances and improvements thereto belonging
