This Deed made this 26th day of May Eighteen Hundred and Sixty two by Samuel S. Hildebrand of Frederick County and State of Maryland, Witnesseth, that in consideration of three hundred dollars the said Samuel S. Hildebrand doth grant unto Joshua H. Hildebrand of said County and State, all his, the said Samuel Hildebrand's right, title, interest and claims both at law and in Equity of an and to the following tracts, parts of tracts, pieces or parcels of land, situate, lying and in the County and State aforesaid of which his father Daniel Hildebrand died seized and possessed, and conveyed to him by deeds by the following persons to wit, by G. P. H. Balch Trustee, April 16th 1832, for 25 3/4 acres of land more or less, by Joseph and Charlotte Fleming his wife, dated April 2nd 1833 for 24 acres of land more or less, by Joseph Smith and Sabella Smith his wife, dated September 12th 1834 for 24 acres of land more or less, by John Ritter dated September 23rd 1837 for 3 3/4 acres and 10 perches of land more or less, by George Wetrow Sr. and Catharine Wetrow his wife, dated August 10th 1838, for 28 acres of land more or less, by John Miller and Sarah Miller his wife, dated March 16th 1840 for four acres and 44 ps of land more or less, all of which deeds are recorded among the Land Records of Frederick County, reference thereto being had well more fully and at large appear, in full simple. ~
