This Deed made this 26th day of September A.D. Eighteen hundred and fifty seven by Dennis Hildebrand, Witnesses, that in consideration of the sum of four hundred Dollars the said Dennis Hildebrand do grant unto Charles Broadrup all my right and title claim and interest in the farm left by my father, Daniel Hildebrand dec^d and containing one hundred and sixteen acres of land, more or less, and adjoining the lands of John Volz, John W. Miller dec^d and others. Witness my hand and seal
