Testimony

At the execution of the annexed Commission issued out of the Circuit Court for Frederick County, and to us directed empowering us to examine Evidence in the Cause depending in the said Court, between Warren Garrett and Job Miller partners trading as Garrett and Miller as Sarah B Carlisle, Administratrix of the goods and chattels &c. of Robert B Carlisle and others, Me, Francis Brangle and J C R Wood, Commissioners therein named, did on the 22nd day of June A.D. 1868, at our Office in Frederick City Md^o then and there proceed to take testimony, as follows: The Complainants filed with the Commissioners as Evidence Exhibits N^o 1, 2, and 3 herewith returned, and there being no witnesses present to be examined the said Commission was adjourned to the 30th day of June A.D. 1868, at which time, and the place aforesaid, we in the presence of the Complainant's Solicitor, proceeded to take the following depositions to-wit:

To the 1st Sub: Warren Garrett, a witness of lawful age, produced on the part of the Complainants, being duly sworn and examined to Interrogatories filed with the Commissioners by the Complainants and herewith returned, deposes and says ~
To the 1st Sub: That he is acquainted with the parties to this suit, ~ Has known them for a number of years. ~

To the 2nd Sub: That he is acquainted with the firm of Garrett & Miller, That it is composed of Warren Garrett and Job Miller. ~

To the 3rd Sub: That he is acquainted with the handwriting of Robert B Carlisle. That the signature attached to Exhibit N^o 1 is in the handwriting of Robert B Carlisle. That he has seen the Robert B Carlisle write ~

To the 4th Sub: That he knew a certain Robert B Carlisle formerly a resident of Frederick County. That the said Robert B Carlisle is dead ~ That he died in Frederick County, in May A.D. 1868. ~

To the 5th Sub: That he is acquainted with the Real Estate whereof the said Robert B Carlisle, died seized and possessed. ~ That the papers marked Exhibits Nos 2 & 3 cover or describe accurately said lands. ~

To the 6th Sub: That the said Robert B Carlisle was married at the time of his death, Sarah B Carlisle is his widow, she lives in Frederick County. ~

To the 7th Sub: That the said Robert B Carlisle left children, 4 in number, and all infants under 21 years of age, They all reside in Frederick County ~

To the 8th Sub: That the personal property of the said Robert B Carlisle is insufficient to pay his debts. ~
