It is therefore this third day of August, in the year Eighteen hundred and sixty Eight, by the Hon John A. Sweeney associate Judge of the Sixth Judicial Circuit of the State of Maryland, sitting in the Circuit Court for Frederick County as a Court of Equity, and by the authority of the Circuit Court for Frederick County as a Court of Equity, adjudged, ordered and decreed, that the land and premises mentioned in these proceedings be sold, and that Sarah E Carlisle of Frederick County, be, and she is hereby appointed a Trustee to make the said sales, and that the course and manner of her proceedings shall be as follows: She shall first file in the Clerk's office of this Court a Bond to the State of Maryland executed by herself with a surety or sureties, to be approved by the Court on the Clerk thereof, in the penalty of Twenty thousand dollars, conditioned
