Deed was Recorded February 15th 1857

1857 February 15th Rec^d Stamp duty. H. P. Tyler, Clerk
This Indenture made this fifteenth day of February in the year of our Lord, one
thousand Eight hundred and fifty one, between Christian Smith, and Mary A. E. Smith
his wife of Frederick County in the State of Maryland of the one part and David Stup
of the County and State aforesaid of the other part, Witnesses, that the said Christian
Smith and Mary A. E. Smith his wife, for and in consideration of the sum of thirteen
hundred and fifty dollars current money to them in hand paid by the said David
Stup at and before the sealing and delivery of these presents, the receipt whereof
they the said Christian Smith and Mary A. E. Smith his wife do hereby acknowledge,
have granted, bargained, sold, aliened, Enfeoffed and confirmed, and by these
presents do grant, bargain, sell, alien, Enfeoff & confirm, unto him the said David
Stup his heirs and assigns all that piece or parcel of land lying and being in the
County and State aforesaid, being part of a tract of land called 'Fieldora', Beginning
for the part hereby intended to be conveyed at a stake at the end of twenty perches on
the south or south eight and a half degrees East one hundred and twenty nine
perches line of the deed from Mary J. Thomas to the said Christian Smith, dated
the fourteenth of May 1839 for one hundred and six acres, one rood, and thirty
five perches, and running thence by and with the said south line, S. 85^o E
57^o ps, then N 84^o 7^o ps to the end of 89^o ps, on the fourth line of deed from Mary J.
Thomas to the said Christian Smith aforesaid, then by and with said fourth line,
N. 88^o W. 57^o ps, then S 80^o 7^o ps. to the first mentioned place of Beginning, containing
thirty acres of land, together with all and singular the rights, privileges and appurten-
ances thereto belonging or in any wise appertaining, And all the estate right
title and interest, trust, property claim and demand whatsoever at law and in Equity
of them the said Christian Smith and Mary A. E. Smith his wife of in and to the
said. To have and to hold the said hereinbefore described piece or parcel of
land with the privileges and appurtenances thereto belonging, unto him the said
David Stup his heirs and assigns, to the only proper use and behoof of him
the said David Stup his heirs and assigns forever.
