

personal, which shall remain after the payment of my debts, funeral charges, and the pecuniary legacy herebefore specified, to be equally divided among my sons John L., Samuel L., Jacob L. and George L., and my daughter Sarah Davis, wife of Alfred Davis, and Barbara Catharine Moore, wife of William Moore, in equal proportions, share and share alike, and one equal share or proportion to be equally divided between Charles and Thomas Eagle, the children of my daughter Sarah Eagle, de. est., and also an equal share or proportion to be equally divided between Samuel and Sarah Schwartz, the children of my daughter Ann Mary Schwartz, deceased, and also an equal share or proportion to be equally divided between the children of my son Henry Le Royer de. est., who may be living at my death.

And lastly. I do hereby constitute and appoint my sons John L. Royer of Carroll County Maryland, and Samuel L. Royer of Frederick County Maryland, to be the Executors of this my last will and testament, revoking and annulling all former wills by me heretofore made, ratifying and confirming this and none other, to be my last will and testament.

In testimony whereof, I have hereunto set my hand and affixed my seal this 20th day of June in the year of our Lord One thousand Eight hundred and Sixty Six.

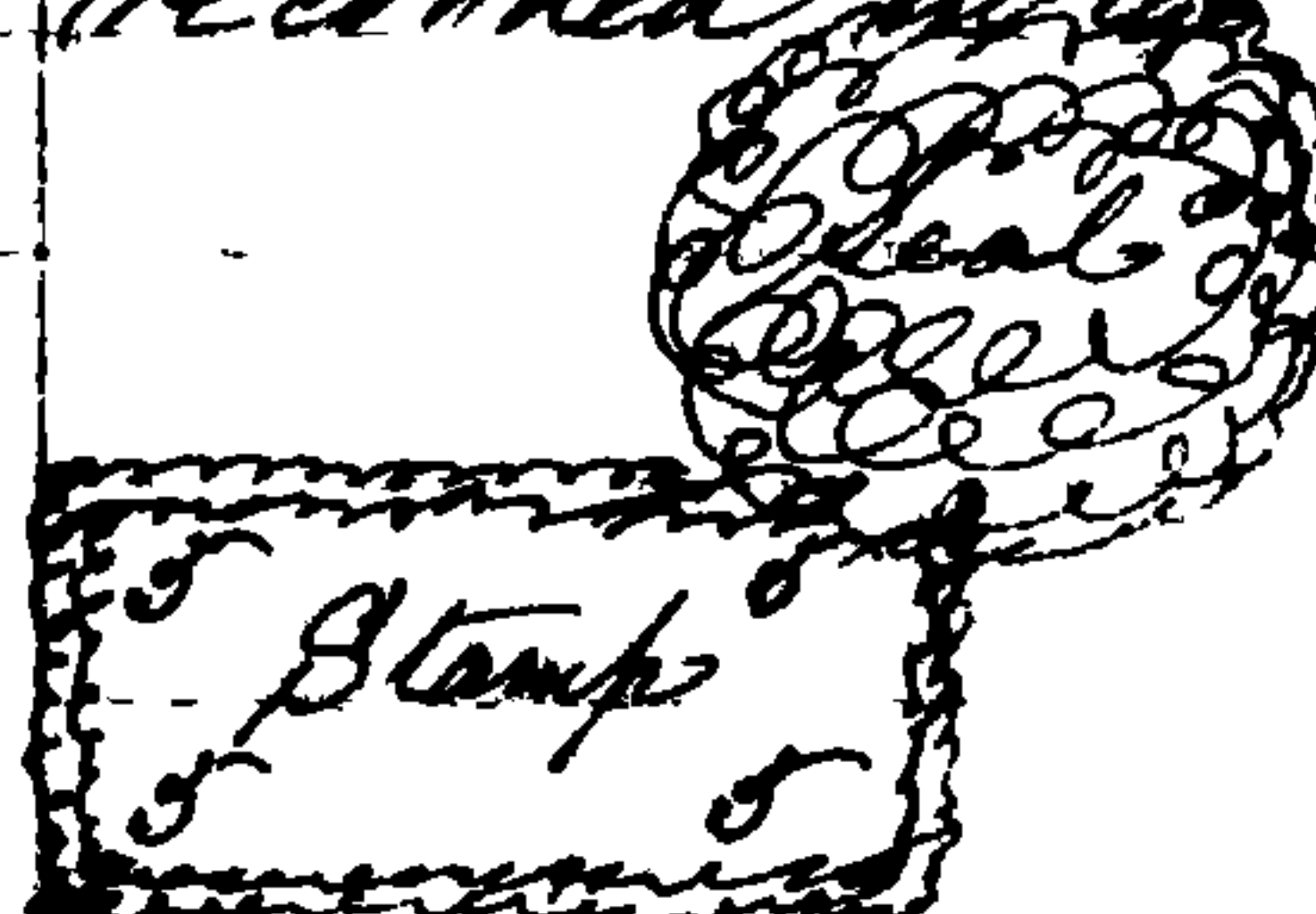
