

Henderson and Gustavus Henderson trading as John Henderson & Co. of the City of Baltimore, State of Maryland, obtained a Judgment in the Circuit Court for Frederick County, at the October term of said Court for the sum of One hundred and forty one dollars and twenty four cents, with interest from the 19th day of February 1866, and costs of suit, against the said William H. Lealey - and that on the 22nd day of October 1867, a certain Paltial Le Rowland of the State of Pennsylvania, in said Court and at said October term, obtained a Judgment against the said William H. Lealey for the sum of four hundred and sixty eight dollars and seventy five cents, with interest from the ninth day of January 1868 and costs of suit, as will appear by reference to certified copies of said Judgments herewith Exhibited Marked Exhibits Nos. 6 & 7. ~

Your Complainants further state that a certain George Le Michael formerly a resident of Frederick County, but residing now in the State of Ohio on the 24th day of February 1868, in the Circuit Court for Frederick County at the February term 1868 of said Court, obtained a Judgment against John St. Pope and William H. Lealey for the sum of seventy five dollars, with interest from the 24th day of February 1868, and costs of suit, and at the same term of said Court on the 30th day of March 1868 James H. Cox Jr., William P. Cox, Samuel C. Cox and Richard W. Cox, trading as Cox Brothers & Co. obtained a Judgment against William H. Lealey for the sum of three hundred and thirty three dollars and eighty six cents current money, with interest from the 20th day of March 1868 and costs of suit, as will appear by reference to certified copies of said Judgments herewith exhibited, marked Exhibits Nos. 8 & 9.

Your Complainant further states that Paltial Le Rowland and George Le Michael are now residents of the State of Maryland, and do not reside therein.

To the end therefore that the Defendants hereinafter named may answer the several matters and things hereinbefore stated, as fully and particularly as if they were herein again repeated, and they were thereunto specially interested, and that the Mortgage premises aforesaid may be sold for payment of your Complainant's claim with interest as aforesaid and that your Complainant may have such other and further relief as the nature and Equity of his Case may require. ~

May it please your Honors to grant unto your Complainants an order of Publication, giving notice to the said Paltial Le Rowland and George Le Michael, who are now residents as before stated, of the substance and effect of this Bill, and warning them to appear in this Court in person or by solicitor, on or before a certain day, to answer the premises, and show cause if any they have, why a decree ought not to pass as prayed, and also a writ of Subpoena, against the said William H. Lealey, Joseph S. Miller, the Franklin Savings Bank of Frederick, the Mayor Aldermen and Common Council of Frederick, all of Frederick County, State of Maryland, and John Henderson and Gustavus Henderson, partners trading as John Henderson & Co., James H. Cox Jr., William P. Cox, Samuel C. Cox and Richard W. Cox, partners trading as Cox Brothers and Co. of the City of Baltimore, State of Maryland, commanding them to appear in this Court at some certain day to be therein named, to answer the premises, and abide by and perform such decree as may be passed therein and as in duty he ~
