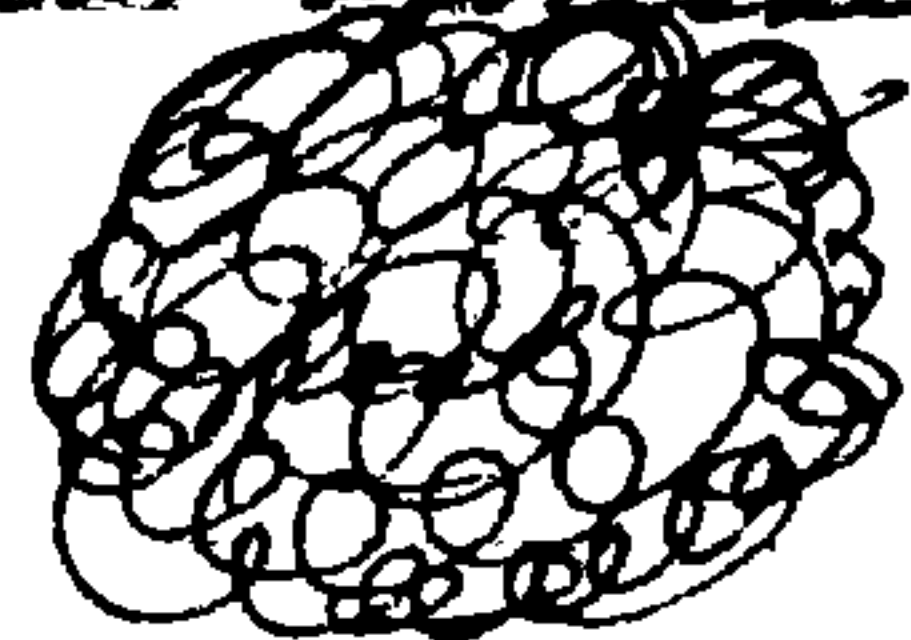

Order of Public Sale by County Trustees for Nancy Taylor as William H. Lealey Joseph J. Miller and others

No. 3411 Equity In the Circuit Court for Frederick County in Equity

The object of this suit is to procure a Decree for a Sale of certain mortgaged premises situate in Frederick City Frederick County Maryland, which were mortgaged by the said Defendant William H. Lealey to Gregory County Trustee, Complainant.

The Bill states that on the twenty ninth day of April in the year Eighteen hundred and sixty three, was indebted to the complainant by his promissory note of that date payable on or before the twenty ninth day of April Eighteen hundred and sixty four in the sum of one thousand dollars with interest from date - And to secure the payment of the said note the said William H. Lealey on the twenty ninth day of April Eighteen hundred and sixty three executed his deed of Mortgage conveying to said Gregory County Trustee "all that lot of ground, situate in Market Street, Frederick Town, Frederick County, in the State of Maryland fronting on said Street forty feet more or less, and running back sixty one feet eight inches more or less, and adjoining the property of James D. English and others, and described in Exhibit A filed in said Cause.

The Bill further charges that on part of the aforesaid sum of money, or the interest due thereon except the interest paid up to the twenty ninth day of April Eighteen hundred and sixty six - but that the whole of said sum of One thousand Dollars with interest from the twenty ninth day of April Eighteen hundred and sixty six is still due and owing to the Complainant.

The Bill further states that on the 29th day of September 1866 - The said William H. Lealey, confessed Judgment to Joseph J. Miller for the sum of seven hundred and sixty one dollars and Eighty five cents, with interest from 29th September 1866 - And that The Franklin Savings Bank of Frederick obtained Judgment against the said William H. Lealey, Jacob M. Kunkel, and John Rhodes for the sum of One hundred and twenty five dollars, with interest from the 28th day of April 1864, & Costs of suit, on the first day of April Eighteen hundred and sixty seven, and that on the second day of April 1867 the Mayor, Aldermen & Common Council of Frederick, obtained Judgment against said Lealey and George Hoskins, for the sum of fifty one dollars with interest from the 22nd day of April 1867, and Costs of suit.

The Bill further states that John Henderson Esq. of the City of Baltimore at the October Term 1867 of the Circuit Court for Frederick County obtained Judgment against the said Lealey for the sum of One hundred and Forty one dollars and twenty four cents, with interest from the 1st day of February 1866, and Costs of suit. - And that at said term of Court Patrick
