The Bill further states that George Le Michael of the state of Ohio - at the February term 1868 of the Circuit Court for Frederick County, obtained a Judgment against John St Pipe and said William St Lealy, for the sum of seventy five dollars with interest from the 24th day of February 1868 and Costs of Suit - And at said term of Court James St Coy Jr, William St Coy, Samuel C Coy, and Richard W Coy, trading as Coy Brothers & Co, obtained Judgment against the said William St Lealy for the sum of three hundred and thirty three dollars and Eighty six cents with interest from the 30th day of March 1868, and Costs of Suit, Certified Copies of which are filed in said Bill of Complaint. ~

The Bill further Charges that Patrick Le Rowland and George Le Michael are now residents of the state of Maryland and do not reside therein. ~

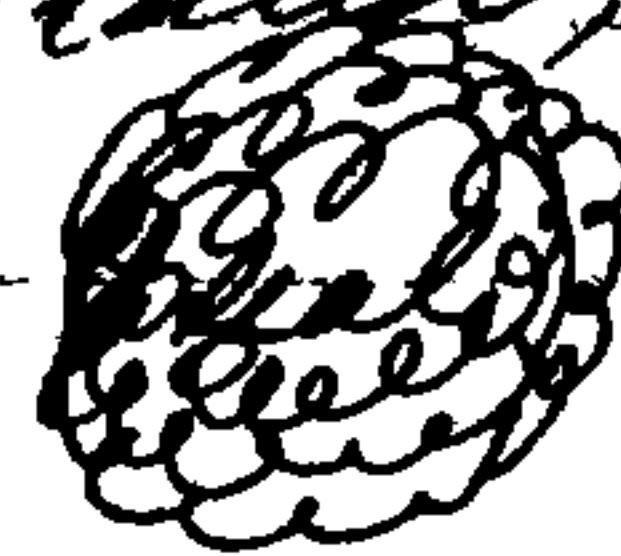
